MORE THAN 120 YEARS OF EXCELLENCE, COMMITMENT AND PASSION

The story about the "Škver", its ships and people, is more than 120 years long. The first lines of this story were written in the far 1896 when Shipyard "Lazarus" started to repair commercial and fishing vessels in the port of Rijeka, one of the most important ports of the Austrian- Hungarian Monarchy.

The Shipyard got its present name after World War II, in 1948, to commemorate its operator, war hero Viktor Lenac. What followed was an era of business expansion resulting in the necessity to move from the centre of Rijeka. Therefore, in the sixties, "Viktor Lenac" moved to its current address - to Martinšćica bay. Embraced by the Kostrena bay, protected from the waves and southern wind by the breakwater, the Shipyard has intensively developed its activities of ship repair and conversion, with a lot of success and prosperity.

In its long history, this 120-year-old shipyard experienced many sunny days but also strong winds and storms. Despite all this, it is still sailing successfully, pushed forward by the excellence, commitment and passion of its employees shown in every new challenging job.

The shipyard, its docks, cranes, ships and people, all its ups and downs, have marked the history of the city on the river Rječina. The Shipyard has always been more than just a company for its hometown - it has been its asset, its heart and its trademark. What is more, outside the Croatian borders, "Viktor Lenac" is an institution whose name is pronounced with respect, it is a reliable partner and a synonym for quality worldwide.
